Caring for an aging America in the wake of a global pandemic.



Required skills, education, and experience:


Most administrative jobs don't require a college education, but basic office and computer skills are a must. What other skills will help you succeed in an administrative role?



MAKE YOURSELF MORE MARKETABLE


